## Art Showing Highlights Conference

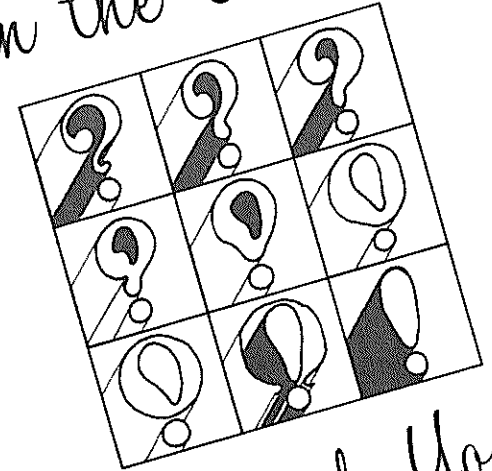
