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ABSTRACT

A valuable resource in New Mexico was close to being lost because of neglect. That resource was irrigation district records. A grant from the Water Resources Research Institute to collect Elephant Butte Irrigation District non-current records allowed New Mexico State University History Department, in conjunction with the University Archives, to preserve these records for all time. In addition, the project will serve as a model for preserving irrigation and conservancy district records throughout New Mexico and the West.

In July 1984 Elephant Butte Irrigation District non-current records were placed in the Rio Grande Historical Collections, located in the New Mexico State University Library. Once housed in the archives, the records went through an archival process of cleaning, arranging and processing. When these tasks were completed, a guide to the collection was compiled to aid researchers.

Research potential from the Elephant Butte Irrigation

District records will draw people from many disciplines. At
their disposal will be numerous boxes of well-organized,
quickly accessible records.

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INTRODUCTION

<u>Justification of Work Performed</u>

Before the Water Resources Archives was created by a grant from the Water Resources Research Institute (WRRI) important historic and legal records from Elephant Butte Irrigation District (EBID) were unavailable to researchers because they were physically inaccessible. Located in a metal warehouse behind EBID headquarters in Las Cruces, New Mexico, these records were unorganized and in danger of becoming permanently lost through damage from dirt, decay and rapid deterioration from uncontrolled temperatures.

Because of the WRRI grant, these records have been collected and preserved for future historical research. In addition, these records are now located in one convenient public depository, safe from the elements.

The Guide to the Elephant Butte Irrigation District Records will serve as a model for preserving records of irrigation and conservancy districts throughout New Mexico and the West.

A Review of Methodology Used

In July 1984 EBID non-current records were packed, labeled and transported to the Rio Grande Historical

Collections (RGHC) located in the New Mexico State University Library. Physical control of the records was obtained when they were received at the RGHC.

Once the records were placed in the university library they went through the archival process of unfolding and cleaning.

Archival arrangement was undertaken to gain intellectual control of the records. The original order of the records, or provenance, was determined where possible. In some fortunate, but not necessarily consistent cases, the original guides to the office files were found and used. However, not all guides were located, if they ever existed, which complicated the task of processing and arranging the remaining records. Some of the records seemed organized according to subject or topic; therefore, they remained together as an entity. Other records had no obvious arrangement. In those cases, the records were arranged chronologically, then topically, or by type of record. Examples arranged in this manner are:

Election Records 1931-1933 & 1941-1963 Legislative Records 1955-1969 Flat Rate Records 1941-1942 & 1959-1963 Audit Reports 1931-1969 Miscellany 1931-1969

Once the documents were organized and cleaned they were placed in acid-free folders and boxes to retard physical deterioration. One final arrangement of miscellaneous

EBID Records completed the process. Each box was labeled, numbered and given a RGHC identification number.

Then a container list was prepared, which is simply a document listing the box and folder numbers and the folder heading. A historical chronology was written highlighting major events in EBID history.

The series description, which is a brief narrative description that details the dates, quantity, type of document and the subject of the collection also was completed.

A Discussion of Results and their Significance

Many disciplines and agencies will benefit from the EBID records guide. At their disposal are more than 340 boxes of EBID records that can be found quickly with the help of a finding aid. A large number of maps and photographs also are included this collection. Those groups that will benfit most from the project include:

- 1. Students of government who can study the operation of quasi-public agencies such as the EBID,
- Agriculture economics students and historians who can now study these records to determine the effects of irrigation in the Mesilla and Rincon valleys,
- Hydrologists who can study the flow of the Rio Grande from documents within the EBID records,
- 4. Sociologists who can examine the relationship between EBID and the community it served,

- 5. Water management experts who can look into the application of water use and attorneys who can delve into land classification matters as well as prior water use,
- 6. Various state agencies, such as the State Engingeer Office, that will find these documents useful,
- 7. Civil engineers who can study the construction of drainage ditches or the building of dams,
- 8. Conservationists who can examine wildlife issues by looking into the biological survey records,
- 9. Archivists who will be able to use this project as a model for saving other water records throughout New Mexico and the West, and
- 10. Historians will find information relating to a multitude of topics within the EBID Records.

Principal Findings

The EBID records contain a wealth of data and historical information. These records once were inaccessible to researchers and valuable data was unavailable or difficult to find. Now however, the records are organized and located an archival depository. A finding aid [duplicated in Appendix B] has been prepared to help the researcher through the voluminous records.

Summary

Organizing and cataloging the EBID records took one year to complete. The first phase of the project involved getting physical and intellectual control of the records. This control was obtained when the records arrived

at the RGHC. Then, after surveying the contents the records were processed and arranged. The final phase was the completion of a finding aid, listing every folder and every box in the collection.

HISTORICAL CHRONOLOGY

of the

ELEPHANT BUTTE IRRIGATION DISTRICT

1888	Col. Anson Mills recommended erecting a dam above El Paso to provide water for El Paso - Juarez Valley.
1893	Dr. Nathan Boyd organized the Rio Grande Dam and Irrigation Company. The company purposed to build a dam at Engle, New Mexico (Elephant Butte) to serve southern New Mexico's irrigation needs.
1896	Secretary of the Interior David Francis issued a directive not to grant a right-of-way above the site of the "international dam" on the Rio Grande. This embargo remained in effect until rescinded by Secretary of the Interior Herbert Work in 1925.
1898- 1909	Time period covering litigation involving Rio Grande Dam and Irrigation Company.
1902	U.S. Congress passed the Reclamation Act of 1902
1904	The U.S. Reclamation Service, pushed by the Nov. State Department, proposed to build the Rio Grande Project (Elephant Butte Dam). The project's jurisdiction covered the waters of the Rio Grande from southern New Mexico, to El Paso and Fort Quitman, Texas, to Mexico.
1905	An agreement for Rio Grande water rights was drawn up by delegates of New Mexico, Texas, and Mexico.
	The Territorial Legislature of New Mexico passed a law providing for the creation of a water users' association within New Mexico. This law met the federal requirements to establish local water users' associations on U.S. Reclamation projects.
1906 Jan. 27	The U.S. Reclamation Service confirmed the Rio Grande Project in New Mexico.
1906 May 21	A convention was held on this date between the U.S. and Mexico determining that 60,000 acrefeet of water would be sent annually to Juarez from the proposed reservoir at Elephant Butte.

The Elephant Butte Water Users' Association was 1906 formed. Stock subscriptions and contracts were sold to farmers for water rights to the Rio Grande. 1908 The Leasburg diversion dam was completed in this Impounded arroyo water was supplied on a rental basis to Mesilla Valley water users. 1909 The State of New Mexico passed a law providing for irrigation districts with broader powers than water users' associations. 1916 May 13 On this date Elephant Butte Dam was completed. Mesilla diversion dam was finished. 1917οn Serious water logging occured due to excessive water use. Contract with U.S. for large-scale drainage system was signed. 1918 Percha diversion dam was completed in Rincon Valley. 1918-1920 EBID replaced Elephant Butte Water Users' Association. 1919 Experimentation with growing cotton began. 1920-1923 EBID attempted to shift more of the cost of the Rio Grande Project to the U.S. government because of the international aspects of the project. 1920 Dec. 11 First public notice was issued for twenty year repayment of construction costs for Rio Grande Project. 1928 Payments changed to \$3.60 per acre for the water users of the Rio Grande Project, stretching repayment time to 27 years. 1929 Temporary Rio Grande Compact froze all water use for five years or until permanent compact was ratified. 1931 Rio Grande Project payments extended over 40 years. 1938 Final Rio Grande Compact was drafted. 1939 The Rio Grande Compact was ratified by the United States government. May 31

The significance of the Rio Grande Compact was that it created an alliance between EBID and El Paso Water Improvement District. Water deliveries for both EBID and El Paso Water Improvement District came from the Elephant Butte Reservoir thus placing them against water districts to the north. From this point on friction between EBID and the Middle Rio Grande Conservancy District in Albuquerque would grow.

- 1937 EBID and the El Paso Water Improvement District surrendered their rights to the electrical power production at the dam to the U.S. for a reduction of payment to the sum of \$2,410,000.
- 1938 Rectification of the Rio Grande below Caballo Dam due to flooding in Mexico.
- 1950 1970 Period of conflict over the maintenance of the
 Elephant Butte Reservoir as a recreation pool or as a
 source of water for irrigation.
- 1950 EBID turned to private drilling of wells to supplement surface water supply.
- 1971 Final payment made by EBID District for building of the Elephant Butte Reservoir.
- 19741977 Litigation against EBID from people with private wells. Decision disallowed EBID to supplement surface water with well water.
- 1978 EBID was exempt from following 160-acre limitation as set forth by the Reclamation Act of 1902 by Secretary of the Interior.
- 1979 EBID assumed control over the operation and maintenance of ditches and canals within its district. However, the Bureau of Reclamation remained in charge of the reservoir, dam and diversion dams. In addition, the Bureau of Reclamation continued to control the apportionment of water between New Mexico, Texas and Mexico.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The EBID records measure 115 linear feet of material spanning 63 years (1906-1969). The records are divided into two categories. First, the Elephant Butte Water Users' Association and second, the successor organization, EBID. The bulk of the records was created by the EBID. Within this division, the records are divided into two time periods. The first time period contains the years 1906-1930. The second time period covers the remaining years, 1931-1969. The arrangement of materials covers 70 series topics. In addition to the documents, there are a number of ledgers, maps and photographs.

Within each series there are documents relating to activities of the EBID, which can be divided into internal and external dealings. The internal activities cover the final location for a reservoir, land classification questions and community ditch operations. Other related documents cover operation and maintenance costs, assessments, drainage, and complaints of the water users. The highline canal and hydro- electric power were of concern to the district as was colonizing activities of the Mesilla Valley along with soldier settlement. Damage claims resulted from flooding, ditch breaks and encephalitis outbreaks.

Other concerns dealt with state legislation affecting the EBID, the Rio Grande Improvement Fund, Water Reservoir Fund and laws changing the irrigation district's authority. Another issue invloving EBID documents was the repayment of the loan to the Bureau of Reclamation and the 40 year extension it received during the depression.

The external issues EBID recorded are with other water projects such as the Middle Rio Grande

Conservancy District, Middle Rio Grande Project, the

San Juan-Chama diversion and the Upper Colorado Storage

Basin. The records contain material on boundary and water disputes with Texas. International relations also are dealt with.
